













Hot Dots Community Polling


TOTAL BY SUPERVISOR DISTRICT














Combined Community Polling and Survey Demographics










Race/Ethnicity Comparison to County Population












Age Comparison to County Population









- White: Mental Health and Suicide; Substance Use/Drug Overdose; Child Health; Obesity/Overweight














Adults Who Ever Thought Seriously About Committing Suicide by Gender County: El Dorado



Age-Adjusted Death Rate due to Suicide










El Dorado County Teen (15-19) Birth Rate



Top Health Concerns Summary

- Higher rates of substance use disorder and mental illness
 - The data suggests that El Dorado County has higher rates of substance use that result in Emergency Department visits and sometimes overdose deaths.
 - The rate of deaths due to suicide in El Dorado County has consistently been higher than the rate for California.
- Nearly 20% of adults living in El Dorado County are obese
- Poor mental health and substance use were also identified as areas of concern in El Dorado County's younger population
 - 44% of 11th graders in El Dorado County indicated feeling chronically sad or hopeless in the last 12 months
 - Almost 1/3 of high school juniors reported alcohol or drug use in the past month





Hot Dots Exercise

Using the 4 dots, vote for the root causes you think should form the basis of the Community Health Improvement Plan

- Rules:
 - One dot per root cause or
 - Multiple dots per root cause
 - Can use the priority score if helpful, but not required
 - Essentially no rules
